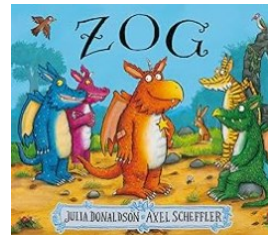
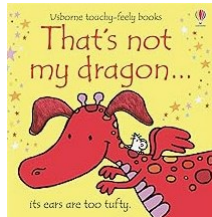

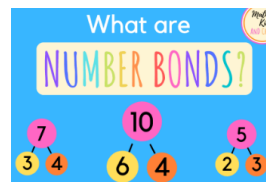
- Phonics– following the Little Wandle SEND programme.

Number, Multiplication & Division, Shape, Pattern

- Number Consolidation: number bonds to 20 and 1:1 correspondence
- Number: Addition and Subtraction, completing number sentences and knowing what the symbols represent
- Number: Multiplication and Division, doubling, halving, substituting, using arrays and number patterns to begin simple multiplication sums

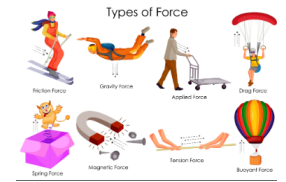
