The form will tell us what you and your child have decided around fasting. Such as, if they will be fasting on certain days from certain times, whether they can drink water or not and what you want us to do if your child feels unwell. As per the NHS advice sheet, we do not encourage children under the age of 7 fast during school so please be mindful of this.
