As a school we feel it is extremely important that we do not ignore the extreme changes that are planet is going through. We must contribute to our community and think of our future generations.


At Priory school we believe it is crucial that we look at the bigger picture, and show our support to our community and the world, by taking action!

We have been exploring superheroes, both real life and the kind that can fly! In art we have been making superhero masks too.









Year 2 News


