Our Learning

English

We have had lots of fun continuing to explore the story 'Where the Wild Things Are'. The children have been exploring colours associated with each character, and have been practising writing key vocabulary from the story too! Some children have also been trying to build sentences using their colour knowledge.

Maths

The children have been continuing to expand their number knowledge. Some children have been exploring the number '8', whilst others have been cementing their understanding of numbers 1–5. We have had lots of fun using hopscotch, big Numicon, and going on number hunts.

This week the children have been looking at the key objects that appear in the story. They have made 3D boats and beds taking inspiration from the colours and textures in 'Where the Wild Things are'. They have also been exploring high and low pitch in music.
