The children are now able to access reading book online at their level. There is are log in details in their home school books. New books will be added weekly.

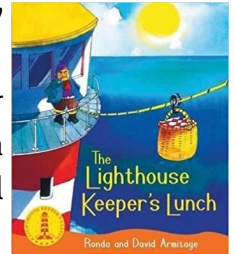
Our Learning

English

This week, we have been looking at 2D shapes. We counted the sides & vertices, made patterns using 2D shapes and sorted the shapes into different categories. Next week, we will move onto 3D shapes.
