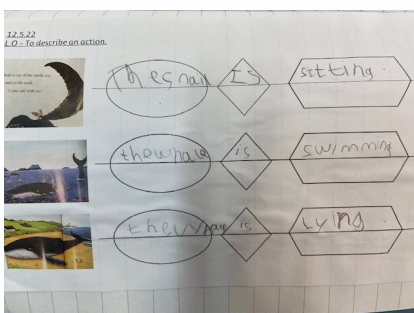

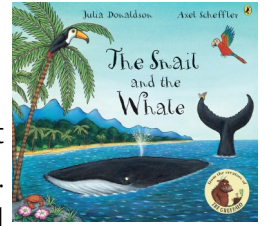

Our Learning

English

This week in class, we have been looking at describing the characters using adjectives. We sorted adjectives to describe either the snail or the whale. Then, we wrote sentences using the 'what like' shape coding sentence frame.



We also have been looking at what the characters are doing. We matched verbs to pictures from the story. Then, we used the vocabulary to write 'what doing' sentences.

Next week, we will sequence the story and describe the setting.

Mrs Toland's maths

This week, we have been using number lines to subtract. We had to be careful to start on the first number in the number sentence, count backwards and make sure we do the correct amount of jumps. Next week, we will continue to practice this method.

Miss Hall's maths.

This week, Miss Hall's maths group have been using column subtraction to two 2-digit numbers. Next week, they will continue to practice this method.

Afternoons.

This week, we have continued our Science topic all about plants. We took part in a plant scavenger hunt to see which plants grow in our school. We also looked at the different parts of a tree.
