Our Learning

English

This week in class, we have been exploring the different places the Queen visited in our story of the Queen's hat. We took part in a scavenger hunt where the children had to find the different London locations hidden around the school. Finally, we demonstrated our knowledge of the story by sequencing the events and we used shape coding 'what like' sentences to describe the Queen. Next week, we will be recapping verbs by looking at what the Queen is doing.

This week, we have been looking at part-whole models. We used ten frames and counters to show addition problems and wrote part-whole models to match. Next week, we will be introduced to the addition symbol.

Miss Hall's maths.

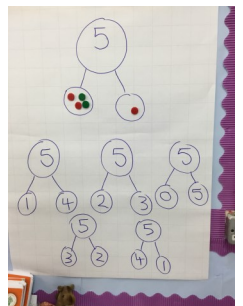
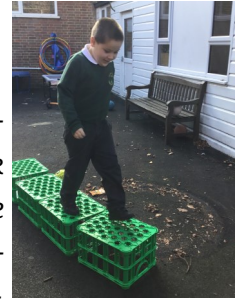
This week, Miss Hall's maths group have been adding two-digit numbers using number line. Next week, we will begin using column addition to add.

This week, we have been learning about the country of Ireland. We have sorted the human and physical features such as The Giant Causeway and the Titanic museum and made our own Celtic knots.

As part of Science week, we have looked at how animals and humans grow. We planted our own lentils which we will watch over the next few weeks and created hand print flower pictures.

In busy learning, we have been exploring our 5 senses. We played a memory games (sight), took part in a sensory walk (touch), smelt a range of items such as lemon (smell) and were blindfolded and had to guess which instrument was being played (sound).

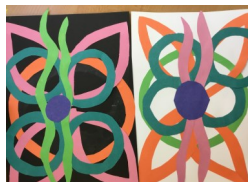
