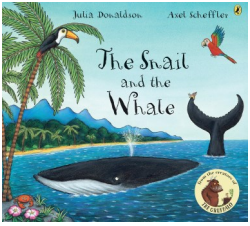

Our Learning

English

This week in class, we have been exploring our new story – The Snail and the Whale. We created our own curious snail out of clay and looked at the key vocabulary in the story. Next week, we will look at nouns, identify who is involved in the different events in the story, and think about how the characters are feeling.



Mrs Toland's maths

This week, we have been using pictorial representations and maths equipment, such as counters and tens frames to subtract. Next week, we will continue to practice our subtraction skills.

Miss Hall's maths.

This week, Miss Hall's maths group have been practising their subtraction of ones and tens. Next week, they will learn how to use column subtraction to subtract from a 2-digit number.

Afternoons.

This week, we have started our new Science topic all about plants. We looked at how we can identify if an object is a plant, such as does it grow in soil or does it need water to grow. We then sorted pictures into those which were plants and those which were not plants. We also looked at how we grow plants and sequenced the steps. Next week, we will plant our own flower and observe how it grows over the term. We will also look at the different parts of a plant.
