

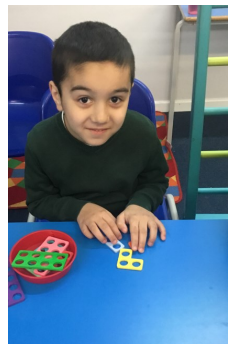


Peek of the Week Woodland – 4th March 2022.

English

Miss Hall's maths.

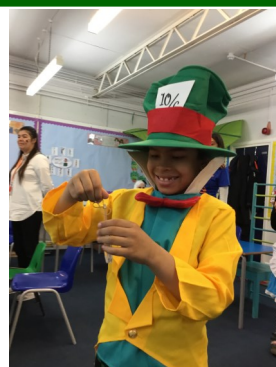
This week, Miss Hall's maths group have been adding ones using a number line. Next week, they will be adding tens using a number line.

Afternoons.

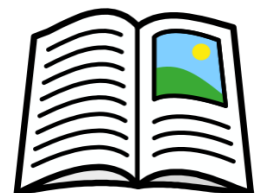
