Our Learning

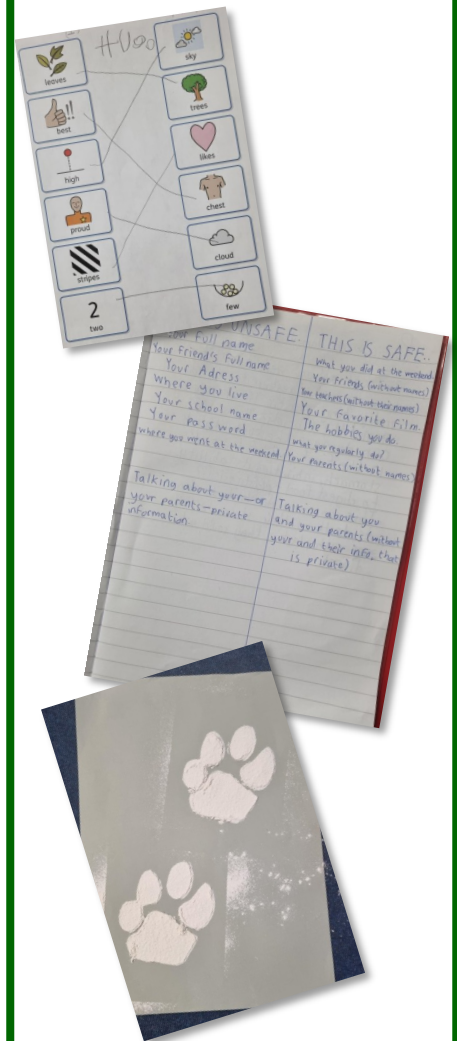
Woodlands Owls:

In years Reception, years 1, 2 and 3 we have been exploring jungle animals as we work through our new stories– 'Animal Boogie' and 'Rumble in the Jungle.' We have been moving and communicating like the jungle animals as we role-play their ways of moving. We've been exploring rhyming words to use when describing the animals.

Years 3 and 4 have been looking at traditional fairy tales and have been exploring them in greater detail to try and find out more information from the stories. What would YOU do if a wolf came to eat you, or would you climb up a giant beanstalk?

In year 6, we have been talking about how to be safe online. Although technology has helped us in so many ways, it can be hard to know if the things we are doing are safe. We've discussed what information we should and shouldn't share, who we should talk to when we're feeling unsafe, and how to tell if a site is safe or not. Year 6 have worked really hard and have been looking at their own profiles to see how to make themselves even safer.
