Woodlands Owls:



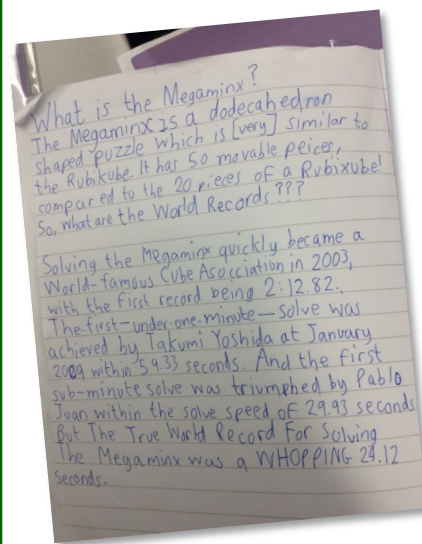
As part of our learning about our topic book 'First Day at Bug School', Miss Hall did a sensory

version of the story where we got to take part in all the different lessons that the bugs did. We had maths puzzles, books, musical instruments, PE equipment and more.

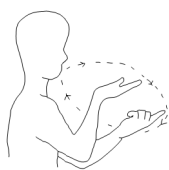
