### Our Learning

In maths this week, we have been working hard to count in 2s, 5s and 10s which is something it would be really good for the children to continue practising at home. We have also been working out number bonds to 10 which we would like the children to practise at home. Next week, the children will be focusing on adding for example  $32 + 5$ . We would like the children to put the 32 in their head and then count on 5.

In English, the children are going to be looking at the difference between cities and the rainforest then they will be using this knowledge to write some poetry. It would be fantastic if you could read some poetry with your children so that they can start to learn the difference between a story and a poem. In the afternoon lessons, the children will be looking at the lifecycle of animals in science. It would be really good if children have time at home to practise their handwriting with a focus on ensuring they have finger spaces and their letters are the same size. It would also be good to practise capital letters.
