Next Friday is Football day–Football kits/ P.E. kits worn to school.

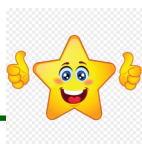

thermometer

Our Learning

This week, in Maths we have been continuing to practise how to tell the time. We have also been reading scales on thermometers when the scales are in intervals of 1,2 and 5.

The children have also been looking at the properties of 3D shapes specifically cubes, cuboids, spheres and pyramids. In English, we have been looking at the key features of newspaper reports. After re-enacting the rescue of the whale in our story, we have been planning and writing our very own newspaper report of this miraculous event!

Next week, the children will be consolidating some of the skills that they need to be really secure in which would be great for the children to practise at home. This includes: telling the time, number bonds to 20, how to use the inverse to check calculations and their 2,5 and 10 times table. Next Friday, it is Football day at school so the children can wear football kits/ P.E. kits to school. The children should wear trainers and no football boots for this exciting day.
