### Our Learning

**This week**, in Maths the children have been looking at statistics. We have been making tally charts and learning how shapes represent different amounts in pictograms.

If your children can continue to practise their 2, 5 and 10 times table then this will really help.

In English, we have been using drama techniques to explore how the characters in our story are feeling. We have been building up to write a diary entry about this from their point of view.

In Science, we have been celebrating Science week and the theme for this year is Growth. During the week we have been creating seed bombs and Lentil men by planting seeds in cups. We have also been using different equipment around the school to create our own exercises to keep fit.



**Next week**, in Maths we are going to be looking at 2D shapes, it would be really good if you could look for different 2D shapes around the home. Then you can talk about how many sides and vertices your shape has. In English, we will learn about the features of a persuasive letter and then plan and write a letter to Mrs Foster suggesting ways that we could improve our school and local area through planting.
