This week, in Maths, the children have been learning about 3D shapes and how many faces there are on each shape. We have also been doing some assessment papers to see how we are getting on with our Maths. In English, we have been completing written reading comprehensions using some of the key skills we have been practising recently such as scanning for key words and using evidence in the text to answer the questions. In Geography we have been using various ways to find information on Wales, Northern Ireland and England, including research on laptops, in books and a scavenger hunt on the playground.

Next week, we have our wonderful trip to Windsor Castle on Monday which will a fantastic opportunity to learn all about the castle's history. In Maths, we are going to be learning about equal parts and halves.

In English, we will be planning and writing a recount of our trip to Windsor castle. We will be focusing on writing in the past tense and using time adverbials to describe the order in which the key events took place (First, Next, Then, Finally...etc). In RE, we will learning to re-tell the Easter story and understand what Jesus' resurrection means to Christians.
