Our Learning

This week, the children have been busy learning about different animals: elephants, giraffes and lions. They have been gathering information that they can use to create their own fact file. If you have time at home, it would be lovely if you can look at different fact files and talk to your children about the main features: pictures, headings, subheadings, introduction and captions. In Maths, the children have been becoming familiar with a number square, they are able to find 10 more, 20 more, 6 more using the number square.

Next week, in English, we will be moving on to the children writing their own fact file about their chosen animal. In Maths, we are going to be adding two digit numbers using a number line. If you would like to know how to help your child with this at home, please speak to their class teacher. In Geography, the children are looking at a town in Kenya and comparing it with Burnham.
