Our Learning

This week, the children have been working hard in maths this week looking at fractions. The children are now able to draw a half and a quarter of a shape. It would be really good if the children can continue to practise at home finding half and a quarter for example cutting a cake in half etc. In English, we had a very exciting lesson recreating the story of 'The Snail and The Whale' then the children wrote an email telling a friend all about what happened.

Next week, the children are going to be looking at symmetry of shapes for example, does the square have a line of symmetry? The children can cut out the shape and then fold it to see if it has a line of symmetry. In ICT, the children are learning what an algorithm is and the importance of ordering instructions.

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
