This week, in Maths we have been learning how to tell the time. The children are now more confident telling the time to half past the hour and quarter past. It would be good if they can continue to practise all of these at home and quarter to. In English, this week we have 'travelled' to the polar regions and a tropical rainforest and have written diary entries in role as the Snail about what we saw there.

Next week, in Maths we are going to continue practising how to tell the time. We are also going to be reading scales on thermometers when the scales are in intervals of 1,2 and 5. The children are also going to be looking at the properties of 3D shapes specifically cubes, cuboids, spheres and pyramids. In English, we will be looking at the key features of newspaper reports.
