This week, we have had our wonderful trip to Windsor Castle on Monday which was a fantastic opportunity to learn all about the castle's history. In Maths, we were learning about equal parts and halves. In English, we have been planning and writing a recount of our trip to Windsor Castle. We have been focusing on writing in the past tense and using time adverbials to describe the order in which the key events took place (First, Next, Then, Finally...etc). In RE, we have been learning to re-tell the Easter story and understand what Jesus's resurrection means to Christians.

After Easter, in Maths we are going to be looking at fractions in more detail. We will be focusing on recognising halves and thirds then we will be looking three quarters. It would be great if the children can continue to practise their 2,5 and 10 times table. Also, if they can go over their number bonds to 20 this will also help. In History, we are going to be learning about the significance of Grace Darling . In English, we will start to explore our new text 'The Snail and the Whale'.
