## <u>Our Learning</u>

## English

We have been busy planning our pourquoi stories this week. Everyone has created a unique story, from "how a star was born" to "why the moon changes shape every month". Ask your child what their story is about!

Next week, we will be designing and creating a book to showcase our stories and illustrations.

## Maths

This week we have continued our unit about length and perimeter. We have learnt about equivalent lengths, focusing particularly on millimetres, centimetres and metres. The children also enjoyed the challenge of measuring the length of the classroom in metres.

## RE

We have continued with our learning about Easter. The children have learnt why the events leading to Easter Sunday are significant by creating a diary of events, recognising the importance of Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday.

## Geography

This week we have been learning about why rivers are important to people now and in the past. The children have enjoyed exploring the different activities that take place on the river and discovering the ways in which people try to protect the environment.
