## <u>Our Learning</u>

## <u>English</u>

This week the children have planned their own story called 'The Happy Pharaoh' that they will start to write next week. They enjoyed discussing what parts of the original story they could change and how they could use their historical knowledge of Ancient Egypt. In our story plans, the focus has been on what success criteria the children will use in their own narrative.

### <u>Maths</u>

This week the children have explored equivalent lengths (metres, centimetres and millimetres), compared the different ways to measure length and added lengths in different units (metres, centimetres and millimetres). They have also used practical methods to consolidate their learning in the classroom using centimetre and metre rulers (measuring several objects).

### <u>History</u>

We have been exploring timelines in History this week, looking at some of most important events that occurred in Ancient Egypt. We had some fantastic discussions about which events we thought were most significant, and then created our own historical timeline.
