<u>Our Learning</u>

English

We have come to the ending of our story. What a sad ending it was! This week the children have planned their own version that they will start to write next week. The focus has been on what success criteria they will use in their own narrative.

Maths

The children have been multiplying two digit and one digit numbers, with and without an exchange. They have used the following strategies to help them— base 10, partitioning and column multiplication. Please continue to encourage your child to learn their times tables.

History

We had an informative lesson about Ancient Egyptian Gods this week. The children researched various Egyptian Gods. Did you know there were over 2,000 gods, including Horus – God of the Sky, Isis – Goddess of Good Fortune and Protector of the Dead, Nut and Geb – God and Goddess of the Sky and Earth and Amun – God of the Air.

RE

We have started our RE unit-Pilgrimage to the River Ganges by discussing the importance of water in religions, making links with the importance of the River Nile to the Ancient Egyptians. The children have learnt that many religions place significance to water in their worship.
