Our Learning

English

This week we have been very busy writing and editing our own version of Oscar Wilde's story 'The Happy Prince' - titled 'The Happy Pharaoh'. It has been wonderful to see how every story has progressed. After the half term holiday, we will be reading 'How the Stars Came to Be' by Poonam Mistry.

Maths

This week our marvellous mathematicians have focused on measuring length using metres, centimetres and millimetres.
