### Maths

This week, we started a new block of lessons (SHAPES). The children have explored turns, angles (right angles, obtuse angles, reflex angles with a lesson on comparing the angles) and measured and drawn two dimensional shapes accurately (rectangles and squares). They have learnt the differences between horizontal, vertical and diagonal lines. Next week the children will be learning about parallel and perpendicular lines.

This week and next week, the focus is on the 11 and 12 times tables.

### Geography

This week we have learnt what the difference is between weather and climate. The children used atlases to locate places in the world where they thought it might be hot or cold and they gave reasons to explain why. They have also shown the main map of the world.
