# Our Learning

# English

The children have been inspired by our text, "How the Stars Came to Be" by Poonam Mistry, by writing their own poems about the moon using metaphors. All the children have used metaphors correctly to create fantastic imagery. Well done year 3!

## Maths

In maths we have continued to explore money. The children have added and subtracted money and moved onto giving change. We have used a variety of skills such as number lines, counting on and mental methods to help solve money problems. It would be useful if you can ask your child to add two or three items of shopping together and work out change when going to the shops.

Please continue to support your child with their times tables practice. Our focus in lessons is 2, 3, 4 and 5 times tables.

### Science

This week we started our new unit on light and shadow. The children shared their prior knowledge and learnt new words including transparent, opaque and translucent. You can encourage your child to use these words by asking them to describe different materials at home.
