<u>Our Learning</u>

<u>English</u>

We are really enjoying reading our new book 'The Happy Prince' because it has such beautiful illustra-

tions. In our writing this week, we have used alliteration, similes and synonyms to describe characters and settings. We have also begun to include speech in our writing and we have practised using inverted commas. Next week we will explore how



the pyramids were constructed in Ancient Egypt.

<u>Maths</u>

This week, our Mathematicians have explored connections between the 2, 4 and 8 times-tables. They have begun to link multiplying by 4 to doubling then doubling again, and multiplying by 8 to doubling three times. Next week we will begin multiplying a 2-digit number by a 1-digit number with no exchange,
