English

We are all enjoying watching "The Blue Umbrella" and we have been gathering fantastic ideas and vocabulary to use in our own stories, including precise verbs, prepositional phrases and similes. Friday's lesson was particularly enjoyable—with some amazing onomatopoeic words suggested. Next week we will be planning our own story inspired by the film.

Maths

The children have been interested in discussing 2 and 3 dimensional shapes. They have drawn parallel lines, perpendicular lines, polygons, describe 2 dimensional and 3 dimensional shapes (what's the same and the difference between them). Finally, we have discussed faces, edges, vertices and curved surface in 3 dimensional shapes. Next week, the children will start the next block of lesson which is Statistics. The focus this week continues to be on the 11 and 12 times tables.

Geography

This week the children have learnt that biomes are areas of the planet with similar climates, landscapes, animals and plants.

They have enjoyed finding out about the main biomes and they have drawn illustrations with captions to show the key facts they have discovered. The main biomes included desert, aquatic, rainforest, grassland and tundra.
