- child's energy levels up until lunchtime.

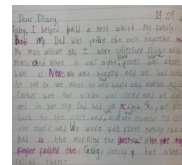
### **Learning together week**

### Our Learning

#### English

This week, we continued reading The Magic finger. We have explored our thoughts and feelings, written a diary entry from the point of view of Philip Gregg, we have discussed our favourite words and phrases related to a scary stormy night and we have drawn our own version of what that looks like in our books. Finally, we interviewed each other and asked questions about their experiences and why they changed their ideas about hunting using Who, What, When, How, Why and Where. Next week the children have the opportunity to use their knowledge of The Magic Finger to



#### Maths

This week, the children have begun to partition numbers to 100, they have started finding 1,10 or 100 more or less of three digit numbers and they are finishing the week with flexible partitioning of numbers up to a 1000. The children have been involved with practical work using dienes to support their learning. Next week, the children will be estimating numbers on a number line to a 100 and to 1,000. They will be comparing and ordering numbers to 1,000.

#### Science

This week, the children have begun to explore rocks. We have discussed the different types of rocks, their properties( size, shape, density, permeability (if it allows water pass through it). Next week the children will be taking part in an investigation with the rocks.

#### Swimming
