English

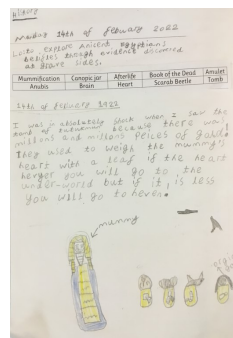
