This week, in geography, we learnt the different ways seas and oceans are important to people. **In art,** we applied what we have learnt from an artist's piece of work and produced an original piece of art work.

In maths, we completed our final lessons on time exploring the 24-hour clock.

In English, we finished our unit on 'The Whale' by writing a letter from Lucy (70 years later) to her grandchild.

Next week, in science, we will be starting a new topic on sound... **in art** we will be using recycled plastic, the Great Wave and our own ideas to create an original piece of art about plastic pollution.

In maths, we will be starting a new topic on Shapes. Within this topic, we will explore the properties of different triangles, understand, compare and order angles.
