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Our Learning

This week, we finished our science unit on Properties of Materials with a final experiment on reversible and irreversible changes. We also started our next geography unit which looks at the migration of refugees and also mountains, earthquakes and volcanoes.

In maths, we continued to apply multiplication strategies to help support us within common factors, prime numbers and square numbers.

In English, we finished our Goodnight Mr Tom unit by creating a newspaper article about how the evacuees settled into Little Weirwold.

In PSHRE, we continued to look at cultural differences within the classroom and how we should be celebrating these differences rather than allowing them to cause conflict.

Next week, we will continue exploring the migration of refugees and will begin our learning on mountains, earthquakes and volcanoes.

In maths, we will continue to explore multiplication and division. Here we will specifically learn to multiply and divide by 10, 100 and 1000.

In English, we will begin our unit on Azzi. This is a picture book which explores the impact of WW2 on our world and the journey of a refugee family as they search for safety.
