

In Science, we looked at a bees life cycle and cre-



This week, we continued with our science unit with an eco-friendly eye: we learnt about life cycles and then explored the importance of bees. We also learnt about scientists that dedicate their lives to conservation.

In maths, we looked at time. We focused on the theoretical and practical side of telling the time using a digital clock and analogue.

In English, we continued to read "Street Child", and delved deep into the text and connecting with the characters through targeted tasks.

Next week, we will finish off our science unit by writing a short story that explains the human life cycle.

In maths, we will begin our new topic 'Volume'. We will particularly focus on cubic cm's, comparing volumes and estimating.

In English, we will continue exploring our text 'Street Child'. We will create opportunities where the children will step into the shoes of our characters, and use it in persuasive arguments, and creating adverts with an emphasis on marketing skills.
