Our Learning

This week, we began our DT unit and learned a range of stitches to join and decorate fabric in order to make a Christmas stocking. We also looked at Christmas traditions around the globe.

In maths, completed our Autumn term assessments and also developed our understanding of adding and subtracting fractions that are less than 1 and greater than 1.
