<u>Our Learning</u>

This week, we began a unit in Geography to develop our knowledge of the world's continents. We also learnt more about different climates and biomes.

In English, we began a unit on biographical writing. We read biographies of Harriet Tubman, Rosa Parks and Benjamin Zephaniah.

In Maths, we began a unit focussing on developing our knowledge of fractions.

Next week, we will be continuing our geography unit by learning about the world's natural resources. In History, we will study the reign of William the Conqueror and the power he had as an absolute monarch. In Maths, we will be continuing to explore fractions with a focus on adding and subtracting fractions and mixed numbers.
