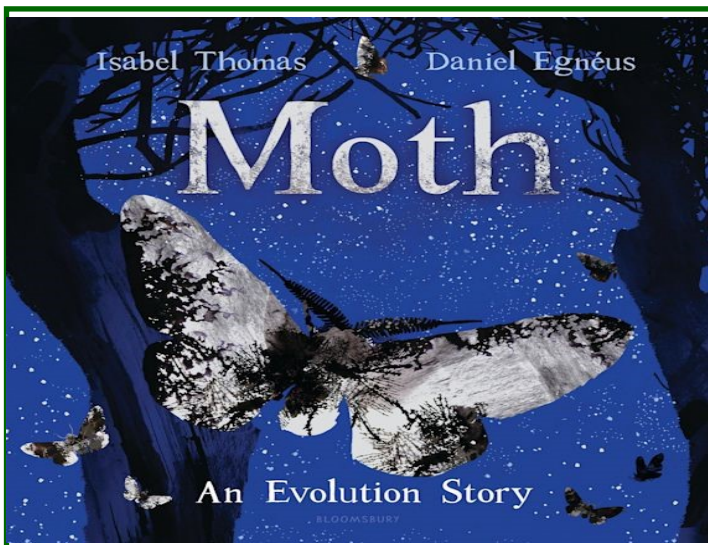
In English, we looked at how a poem is structured and took part in some 'experience lessons' linked to our work in Science.
